FFY 2022 SPP/APR Information

- Final FFY 2022 SPP/APR documents are available on the IDEA Website.
- Reminders
 - Each state must report on the FFY 2022 performance of each LEA in the State on the targets in the SPP/APR.
 - If your state received a FFY 2022 Determination of Needs Assistance for two or more consecutive years must report on
 1. TA sources from which the State received assistance; and
 2. What actions you took as a result of the TA.

Some Reminders for FFY 2023 SPP/APR

- Address any required actions.
- For verification of correction of noncompliance, explain what was done and limit boilerplate language.
- For indicators 8 and 14, analyze the data to determine representativeness and any nonresponse bias. For assistance with nonresponse bias, consider using IDC's [Nonresponse Bias Analysis App](#).

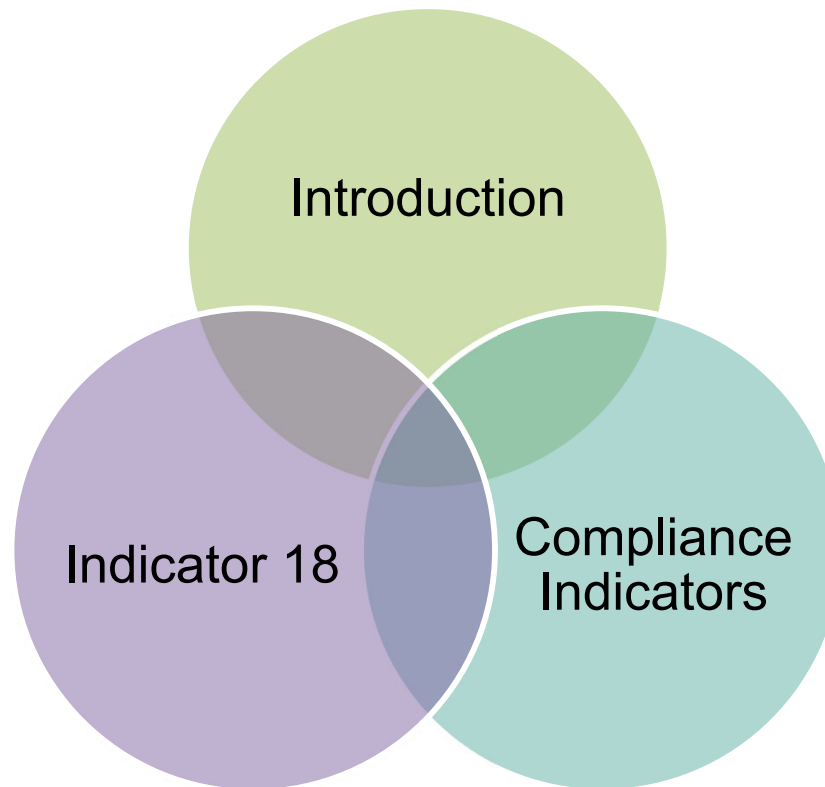
FFY 2023 SPP/APR Updates – General Supervision in the Introduction

- Description of:
 - The process used to select LEAs for monitoring, the schedule and number monitored per year.
 - How files are chosen, including the number selected, for determining compliance with IDEA and verifying the correction of noncompliance.
 - The data system(s) used to collect data and the period from which files are reviewed.
 - How findings are issues: by number of instances or by LEA.

FFY 2023 SPP/APR Updates – General Supervision in the Introduction - Cont

- Description of:
 - Pre-finding correction procedures, if applicable.
 - The state's system of graduated and progressive sanctions to ensure the correction of identified noncompliance.
 - How annual determinations are made for LEAs.
- A web link to information about publicly available general supervision policies, procedures, and processes.
